

Student Expectations

To ensure student success, VIBE has the following expectations of our students:

- ◆ Work on each course a minimum of one hour each school day and keep pace with course work. Students may find they need to put in more time for some courses to complete by the end date.
- ◆ Refrain from emailing or posting inappropriate comments.
- ◆ Communicate with teacher(s) frequently with questions or concerns.
- ◆ Possess a working computer with a reliable internet connection.
- ◆ Follow all other rules, code of conduct, and policies as outlined in the ISD 518 Student Handbook.
- ◆ Report medical absences or other absences to Barry Fischer to be excused or (507)372-1605.

Consequences for not following the above expectations include:

- ◆ Students not meeting attendance and course requirements will be reported for truancy.
- ◆ Students with grade percentages below a C- will be put on academic probation. Academic probation consists of interventions and daily communication with teachers and VIBE staff.
- ◆ Failure to comply with these policies can result in courses being put on hold.
- ◆ Failure to comply with these policies can result in being dropped from VIBE.
