READING

Students will determine meanings of words and phrases in text.

Students will determine meanings of words in academic text.

Students will summarize/retell the story, including beginning/problem, middle, and end/solution.

Students will determine main idea and supporting details of text.

Students will compare and contrast stories, text to self, text to text, text to world.

Students will determine cause and effect in text.

Students will use multiple reading strategies to read grade level text.

Students will use key text strategies to determine important vocabulary, ideas, and details.

Students will read grade level text fluently, accurately, and with expression.

Students will know and apply grade level phonics.

MATH

Students will know four digit addition with regrouping including money.

Students will know three digit subtraction with regrouping including money.

Students will read, write, and represent whole numbers up to 100,000.

Students will compare and order whole numbers up to 100,000.

Students will understand and represent multiplication facts.

Students will understand and represent division facts.

Students will use input/output and number sentences to solve real world problems.

Students will recognize, compare, and order fractions.

Students will use half units when measuring distances.

Students will use time, money, and temperature to solve real world problems.
