

## Statement of Understanding

I, \_\_\_\_\_, understand that by becoming a member of the Worthington Chapter of the National Honor Society, I must agree to meet the following obligations of membership:

1. Members must maintain a 3.5 or better grade point average.
2. Members must attend all regularly scheduled meetings. If unable to attend a meeting, the chapter adviser must be notified prior to the meeting to be excused.
3. Members must participate in each NHS sponsored community event and each NHS sponsored fundraiser.
4. Members must actively participate on at least one committee.
5. Members must volunteer at the Center of Active Living at least 3 times.

Any member who falls below the standards of scholarship, leadership, character, or service may be considered for discipline or dismissal from the Worthington Chapter of the National Honor Society.

If a member fails to perform any of the published obligations of membership, they will be given a written warning and a time period for improvement. If the obligation remains unmet at the end of the warning period, the student will be subject to further disciplinary action by the Faculty Council, which may include probation or dismissal from the chapter.

Violation of the law or school regulations may result in immediate dismissal of the member. These include, but are not limited to:

- DWI
- stealing
- destruction of property
- cheating
- truancy, or
- possession, selling, or being under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
