How will we respond, individually and collectively, when our students have already learned expected outcomes? Develop and implement a plan to adapt instruction to enrich and extend the learning of students who have already mastered expected outcomes. Provide enrichment for students who have mastered expected outcomes through a buildingwide systematic intervention plan. 5. How can we use the evidence of student learning to inform and improve our practice? Share evidence of student learning with each other, identify areas of need, identify effective instructional strategies, and adapt instruction to better meet students' needs. Seek out other staff members, staff development opportunities, professional reading and site visits to learn about best practice and develop strategies to improve instruction.
