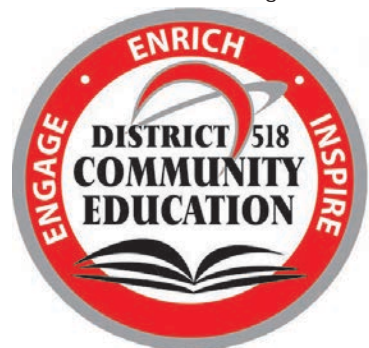
Please take your time paging through this fall/winter catalog. We look forward to seeing you in a class or activity soon.

Worthington District 518 EARLY CHILDHOOD SCREENING

Do you have a child that is 2-5 years old?
Has your child been to early childhood
screening?
If not, read on...

Minnesota State Law requires that
children age 3 1/2 - 4 years participate in a
developmental early childhood screening.
This screening is free. The purpose of the
screening is to identify children who may
benefit from district and community
resources that are available to help in their
development.



The screening will consist of the following components: fine/gross motor skills, language development, concepts, height/weight, vision, hearing, review of child's health history, and immunization record (these are not substitutes for comprehensive exams).

District 518 will be sending out letters of invitation to children who are in the appropriate age range. *If your child is 4 years of age and has not been screened or if you would like to check if your child is listed on our census, contact Tara Thompson, Early Childhood Screening Coordinator at (507) 727-1207 for more information. Early Childhood Screening Dates for this school year are:*

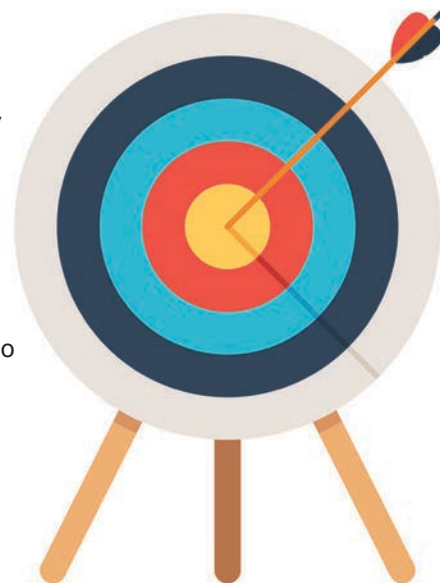

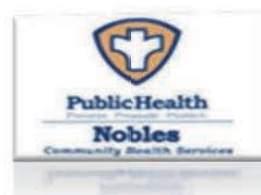

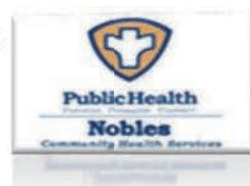

According to the Minnesota state law, people age 55 and older who complete a state-approved defensive driving course are eligible to receive a 10 percent, three-year discount on auto insurance. Contact your insurance agent for details. After you complete the course, you will receive a certificate of completion to give to your insurance company. This 4-hour refresher course is for mature drivers who have completed the initial 8-hour class.

COMMUNITY EDUCATION YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Worthington District 518 Community Education offers youth scholarships to enable more youth to participate in program offerings. As with most other school district activities, Community Education uses the USDA Free and Reduced Lunch application data to determine whether or not local youth are eligible. Children who qualify for Free or Reduced Lunch, will be able to enroll in most Community Education youth activities for a portion of the reduced fee.

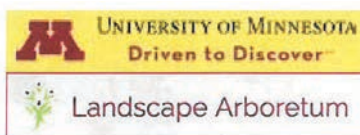

COMMUNITY CONNECTOR AND FAMILY LIAISON PROGRAMS MERGE TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL ASSISTANCE

The Community Connectors and Family Liaisons were previously two separate programs, with some commonalities. Community Connectors assisted people who were seeking community resources and information. Family Liaisons served people who were seeking District 518 school related information and resources. Due to funding limitations, the staff people in these programs do not work full time. So recently it was decided that staff would be cross-trained to provide assistance with both school and community related information/resources. Now, the staff are able to serve more people, which allows people to obtain the help that they need at the time that is most convenient for them.

As these programs merged, a few changes took place. First, Adry Stafford will now serve as the coordinator for the Community & School Liaisons. Second, the program is now asking clients to call ahead to make an appointment. Drop-in appointments will still be accepted, but only as staff time allows.

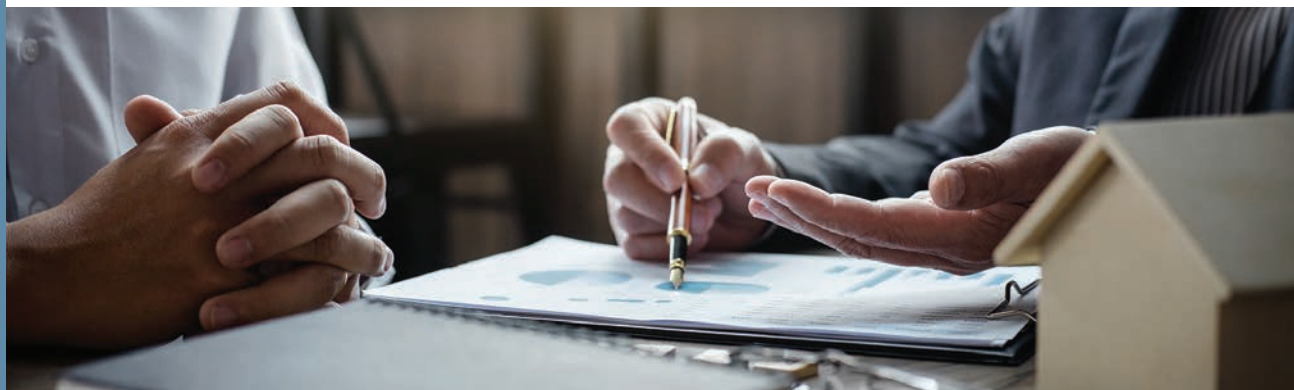

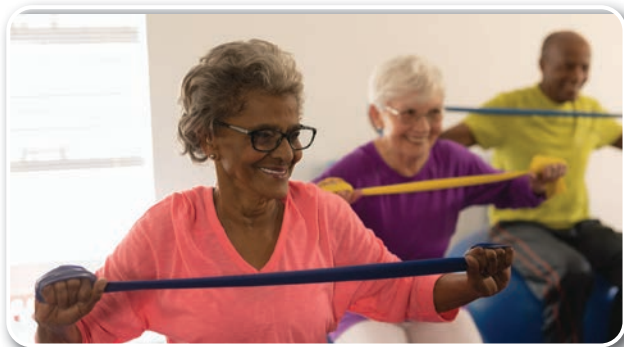

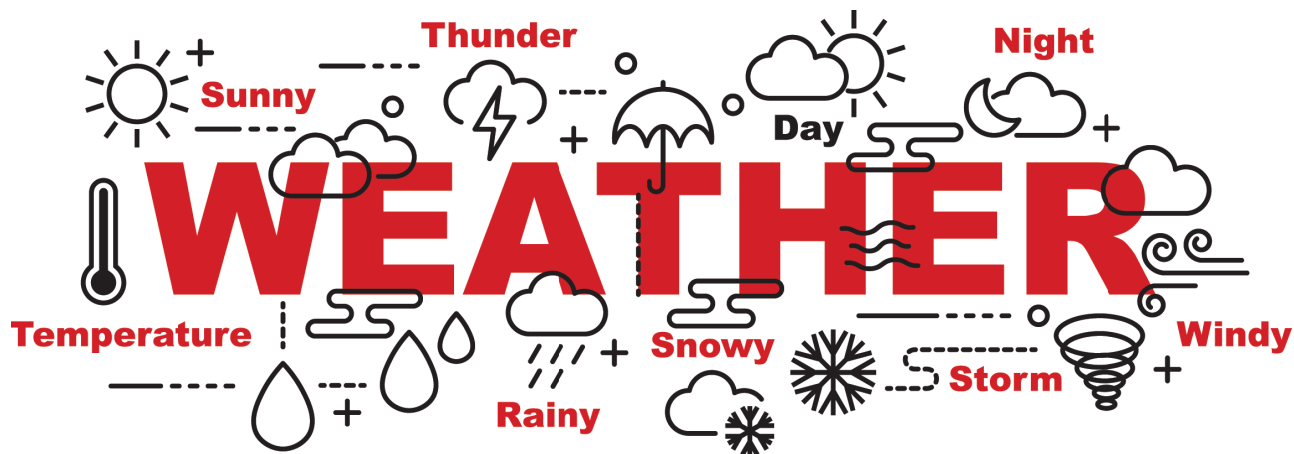

WAMBO is an organization of parents and music educators whose mission is to promote, encourage and maintain an enthusiastic interest in the music programs of District 518 throughout the community.

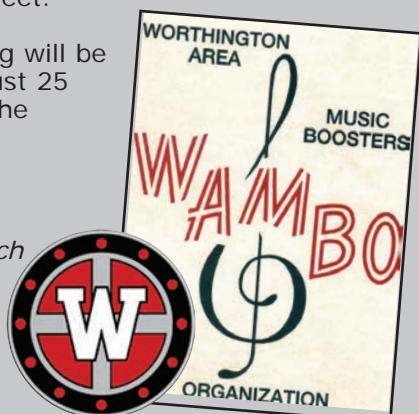

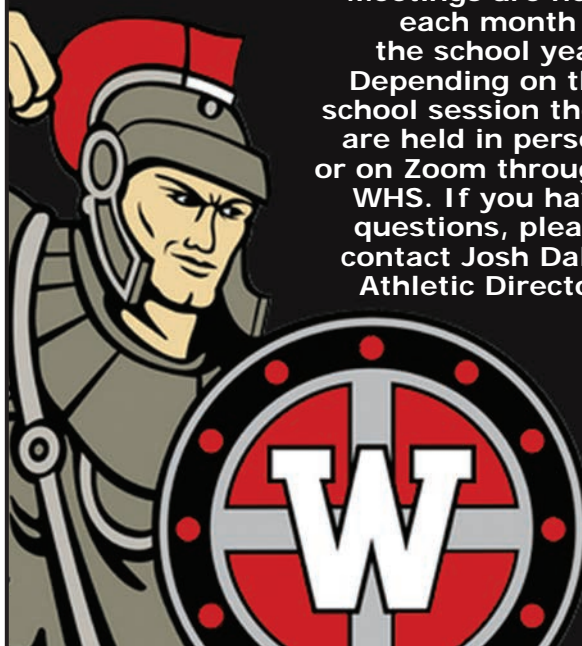

REGISTER ON TIME TO SAVE MONEY
