

YOUTH SOCCER PROGRAM

The Youth Soccer Program is a collaboration between Community Education and a non-profit community group, who in the past couple of years, have been volunteering to teach youth in our community how to play soccer. This soccer program does not require tryouts, so anyone can join the program. Whether you have never played, have some experience, or have played several games before, you are still able to join the program. The emphasis of the program is on fun, developing good sportsmanship, learning the ins & outs of the game, and fostering an appreciation for the game of soccer. Soccer is a sport that contributes to the well-being of children by engaging them in the sport while teaching them the basic movements and skills. The objective is to keep moving and to keep active throughout the summer. The Youth Soccer Program focuses on instructional play and not on competition/tournaments. The players do not travel to play against



other teams nor do other teams come to them to compete. The main focus is to have an environment for learning proper fundamental movement skills such as running, jumping, twisting, kicking, throwing, and catching the ball. Once players have developed some skills, there will be scrimmages or friendly games with other teams. Dates and times of the scrimmages will be determined at a later date.

To obtain these program scholarships, families should indicate their interest in applying for the reduced fee when enrolling their children in a Community Education class or activity. The Enrichment Programs Coordinator will determine whether any additional information is needed to determine if the child qualifies for this income-based program. 



FAMILY & COMMUNITY LIAISON PROGRAMS MERGE TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL ASSISTANCE

The Community Connectors and Family Liaisons were previously two separate programs, with some commonalities. Community Connectors assisted people who were seeking community resources and information. Family Liaisons served people who were seeking District 518 school related information and resources. Due to funding limitations, the staff people in these programs do not work full time. So recently it was decided that staff would be cross-trained to provide assistance with both school and community related information/resources. Now, the staff are able to serve more people, which allows people to obtain the help that they need at the time that is most convenient for them.

As these programs merged, a few changes took place. First, Adry Stafford is now serving as the coordinator for the Family & Community Liaisons. Second, the program is now asking clients to call ahead to make an appointment. Drop-in appointments will still be accepted, but only as staff time allows.



The school year is quickly flying by with an anticipation of spring. The District 518 Community Education staff is excited to have moved into their new building and ready to go with their programming and activities. An open house will be held on Tuesday, March 7. The new storage facility on the grounds close to the Learning Center/Community Education/Intermediate School is almost complete and moving things into that building will start soon.

It has been an excellent few months of progress with our students enrolled in the EDGE and Night School programs in getting students better prepared to grow and be as successful as they can be in the classroom. District 518 staff has worked hard this year on many fronts to provide innovative teaching lessons, assignments, and projects for our students. We appreciate their efforts to adapt and be flexible in working on many levels to keep kids learning and doing well in the classroom.

We are planning for the upcoming school year with some changes in the school calendar for 2023-24. There will not be the 2-day break that has been given for MEA in October. We will be having a one-day break in October, along with an additional day of professional development for our staff in early November. Along with the changes in the fall, there will be a week-long break at the end of March. Graduation is slated to be held on Friday, May 31.

This fall we will be voting on an operating referendum for the district. School districts need operating levies to cover the funding gaps in the state aid formula. The district's operating levy funding expires 2024-25 school year. Operating funds go towards people/staff, programs, and day-to-day operations. The vote will provide funds beginning in the 2025-26 school year. More information and public meetings will be announced in the coming months.



Our boys' soccer team, 2 of our cross country runners, our Region 2AA Triple A Award winner Ivy Jenson, the Spirit of Worthington's trip to Cuero, along with the continued success of the gymnastics team, BPA, FFA, Culinary Arts, FCCLA, Speech team and other groups are giving us much to cheer on in Trojan Pride.
