YOUTH SOCCER PROGRAM

The Youth Soccer Program is a collaboration between Community Education and a non-profit community group, who in the past couple of years, have been volunteering to teach youth in our community how to play soccer. This soccer program does not require tryouts, so anyone can join the program. Whether you have never played, have some experience, or have played several games before, you are still able to join the program. The emphasis of the program is on fun, developing good sportsmanship, learning the ins & outs of the game, and fostering an appreciation for the game of soccer. Soccer is a sport that contributes to the well-being of children by engaging them in the sport while teaching them the basic movements and skills. The objective is to keep moving and to keep active throughout the summer. The Youth Soccer Program focuses on instructional play and not on competition/tournaments. The players do not travel to play against other teams nor do other teams come to them to compete. The main focus is to have an environment for learning proper fundamental movement skills such as running, jumping, twisting, kicking, throwing, and catching the ball. Once players have developed some skills, there will be scrimmages or friendly games with other teams. Dates and times of the scrimmages will be determined at a later date.



*Students may sign up for more than one session, through their age group. Uniform fees are \$30. This is not included in the program fee.

COMMUNITY EDUCATION YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Worthington District 518 Community Education offers youth scholarships to enable more youth to participate in program offerings. As with most other school district activities, Community Education uses the USDA Free and Reduced Lunch application data to determine whether or not local youth are eligible. Children who qualify for Free or Reduced Lunch, will be able to enroll in most Community Education youth activities for the reduced fee.

To obtain these program scholarships, families should indicate their interest in applying for the reduced fee when enrolling their children in a Community Education class or activity. The Enrichment Programs Coordinator will determine whether any additional information is needed to determine if the child qualifies for this income-based program. EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION

Early Childhood Education wraps up preschool with celebratory programs.

The District 518's School Readiness preschool year-end programs/graduations will take place on May 17 & May 18. Families will receive information on their child's program time. This year, 160 children attended School Readiness preschool programs which met three or four half-days per week.

In addition to preschool programs, the Early Childhood department serves families through ECFE classes which are offered in the daytime and evening, in English and Spanish. Families with children birth through pre-kindergarten participated in ECFE classes. ECFE families had the opportunity to enjoy our new facility beginning in February.

District 518 will be expanding its 4-year-old preschool program for the 2023-24 school year.

Beginning with school year 2023-24, District 518 will be offering an all-day 4-year-old preschool program. This will be a pilot year for the program. This opportunity is possible now because additional classrooms were built in the new Community Education facility for this purpose. "We are excited about the opportunity to expand our services," said Community Education director Sharon Johnson. "We will be learning throughout the first year about what works and what can be improved upon."

The number of students served in the program will depend on the number of teachers that the school district can hire by August. Currently, there are enough teachers for 70 students. The program started accepting applications on April 24. Families will be notified on May 19 whether their child has a spot in the program or is on the waiting list. If additional teachers are hired, additional students will be added from the waiting list to the program.



Early Childhood Coordinator to retire in July

Tara Thompson has served as the District 518 Early Childhood Coordinator since 2000. During her tenure the Early Childhood department has grown dramatically. Due to additional funding from the state of Minnesota, the School Readiness program which served 32 families when Tara started, has expanded to enrolling up to 160 children per year. The ECFE program has continued to offer quality learning opportunities for parents to attend along with their children.

During her time in the position, Tara has provided leadership throughout the area by facilitating regional Early Childhood coordinator meetings as well as serving on various initiatives through the Minnesota Department of Education and the Southwest Initiative Foundation. She has been a member of professional associations including Minnesota Community Education Association and the Minnesota Association for Family and Early Education. She was also selected by the Worthington Chamber of Commerce as the recipient of the 2019 Inspirational Woman Award.

Tara has provided outstanding leadership for the Early Childhood programs. A final highlight is that Tara had long dreamed of obtaining an indoor playground space for the Early Childhood department. In February, when Community Education moved to its new building, this dream was realized! Local children will enjoy this asset for decades to come. Thank you and best wishes for retirement Tara!

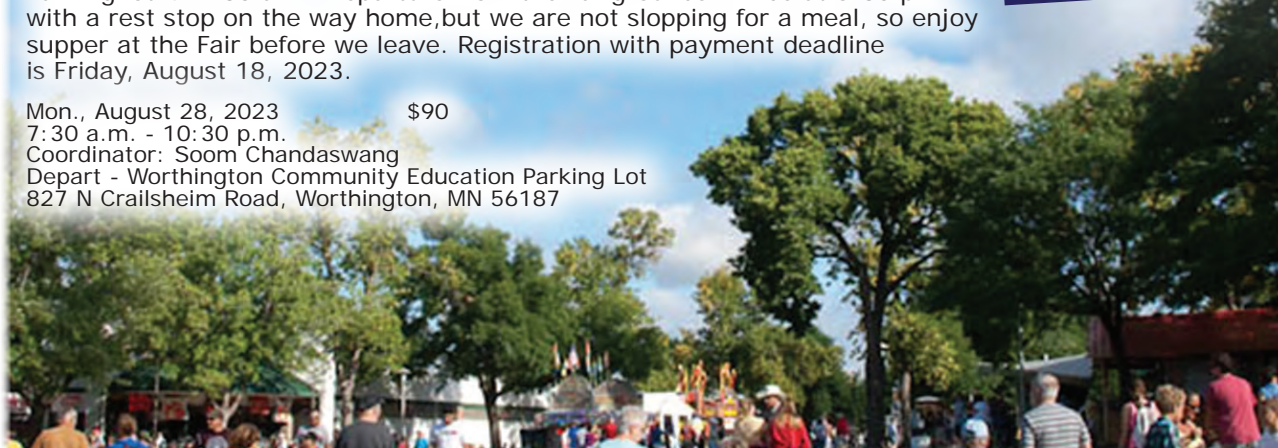
