

Worthington District 518 **EARLY CHILDHOOD SCREENING**

Minnesota State Law requires that children age 3 1/2 - 4 years participate in a developmental early childhood screening. This screening is free. The purpose of the screening is to identify children who may benefit from district and community resources that are available to help in their development.

The screening will consist of the following components: fine/gross motor skills, language development, concepts, height/weight, vision, hearing, review of child's health history, and immunization record (these are not substitutes for comprehensive exams).

District 518 will be sending out letters of invitation to children who are in the appropriate age range.

If your child is 4 years of age and has not been screened or if you would like to check if your child is listed on our census, contact Melanie Kuhl, Early Childhood Screening Coordinator at (507) 727-1207 for more information. Early Childhood Screening Dates for this school year are:

CENSUS INFORMATION NEEDED

Are you new to the community and have young children? Was your baby born someplace other than Worthington? Do you have new neighbors with young children? We need your help! ECFE funding depends upon having accurate information about the children, ages birth to kindergarten who reside in our school district. Please call our office at 507-727-1225 so we can add the child's name to our census data. Being in the census ensures that you will recieve Early Childhood Family Education mailing, be notified for Early Childhood Screening, and recieve preschool and kindergarten information when your child becomes eligible to attend.



Improve your driving skills, and if you're 55 or older, get a discount on your personal auto insurance. This course teaches basic crash prevention techniques and has a proven record of reducing traffic violations and incidents. It is taught by experienced, professional traffic safety instructors. The class consists of lectures, films, and discussions. There is no behind-the-wheel driving and there are no tests. According to Minnesota state law, people age 55 and older who complete a state-approved defensive driving course are eligible to receive a 10 percent, three-year discount on auto insurance. Contact your insurance agent for details. After you complete the course, you will receive a certificate of completion to give to your insurance company. The 4-hour refresher course is for mature drivers who have completed the initial 8-hour class.

Our students have started the mandated testing components that will remain a focus for many of our teachers and students throughout the next few months. These tests provide important information in understanding where the student's knowledge of reading, math, language skills, and science.

The EDGE (Enrichment Directed towards Gaining and Extending knowledge) after school program for students in grades kindergarten through 8th grade has helped our students work on their math and reading skills. EDGE also helps with social and emotional skill building for students that need that additional guidance. Currently, this year Prairie Elementary (K - gr. 2) has 142 students, the Intermediate School (gr. 3 - 5) has 43 students, and 99 students at WMS. This number might increase after parent teacher conferences, testing, or a student is having frustrations in the classroom as the year progresses. EDGE is offered after school and during summer school for District 518 students.

The availability of credit recovery and night school has been beneficial to many of our high school students from WHS and the Learning Center. We currently have approximately 200 WHS/LC students taking night school at the Learning Center to earn credit recovery towards earning their high school diploma. Our VIBE (Virtual Instruction by Excellence), an online program, currently has 645 students participating in classes from home. These programs will help in working with students to keep them on track in the classroom and towards graduation.

The school year has quickly flown by this year, and we are anticipating the arrival of spring. Our construction projects continue to move along, and we are getting ready for the additional project at WMS to start this spring and summer. We will be completing the parking lot updates that were started

last summer and will be working on the main front parking lot of the building. West Learning Center started the long-awaited demolition process on January 31, 2024.






















BREAKING LANGUAGE BARRIERS:

HOW TALKINGPOINTS STRENGTHENS FAMILY-SCHOOL COMMUNICATION

While classroom instruction is vital, effective communication with parents and guardians can significantly contribute to student success. Within District 518, thirty-seven different languages are spoken in our students' homes. District 518 strives to keep families involved and informed regarding their child's education. To successfully navigate multilingual communication, district staff began using TalkingPoints this past September. This is a program designed to specifically enhance the communication between educators and families.

Talking Points is a two-way, multilingual family engagement platform. Teachers send messages to parents in English. The message is received as a text message on the parent's phone in their home language. The parent can respond back to the teacher in their home language and the message is translated seamlessly into English for the teacher. Messages can be translated into 140+ languages using a combination of artificial intelligence and human translation. Short videos, photos, and documents can also be sent through these messages.

Parents have the option to download the TalkingPoints for Families app from their phone's app store or wait to receive a text message from District 518 staff. Parents who choose to use the app to receive messages will not receive text messages. Using the app to receive messages has a few advantages including: the ability to read-aloud the message in the parent's home language and to organize their family's messages.

Staff and families in ISD 518 have welcomed the program. To date, there have been 49,964 messages sent between staff and parents/guardians. Research shows that parent engagement with schools is closely linked to better student behavior and attendance, higher academic achievement, and enhanced social skills. The more parents and teachers share relevant information with each other about a student, the better equipped both will be to help that student achieve academically.



Si bien la instrucción en el aula es vital, la comunicación efectiva con los padres y tutores puede contribuir significativamente al éxito de los estudiantes. Dentro del Distrito 518, se hablan treinta y siete (37) idiomas diferentes en los hogares de nuestros estudiantes. El Distrito 518 se esfuerza por mantener a las familias activas e informadas con respecto a la educación de sus hijos. Para navegar la comunicación multilingüe con éxito, el pasado mes de septiembre el personal del distrito comenzó a utilizar TalkingPoints. Este es un programa diseñado específicamente para mejorar la comunicación entre los educadores y las familias.

TalkingPoints es una plataforma de participación familiar bidireccional y multilingüe. Los maestros envían mensajes a los padres en inglés. El mensaje se recibe como un mensaje de texto en el teléfono de los padres en su idioma natal. El padre puede responder al maestro en su idioma natal y el mensaje se traduce al inglés, sin interrupción para el maestro. Los mensajes se pueden traducir a 140+ idiomas utilizando una combinación de inteligencia artificial y traducción humana. También se pueden enviar videos cortos, fotos y documentos a través de estos mensajes.

Los padres tienen la opción de descargar la aplicación TalkingPoints for Families desde la tienda de aplicaciones de su teléfono o esperar recibir un mensaje de texto del personal del Distrito 518. Los padres que elijan usar la aplicación para recibir mensajes no recibirán mensajes de texto. El uso de la aplicación para recibir mensajes tiene algunas ventajas, entre ellas: la capacidad de leer en voz alta el mensaje en el idioma de los padres y organizar los mensajes de su familia.

El personal y las familias de ISD 518 han recibido con gusto el programa. Hasta la fecha, se han enviado 49,964 mensajes entre el personal, padres y tutores. Las investigaciones muestran que la participación de los padres con las escuelas está estrechamente relacionado con un mejor comportamiento y mejor asistencia, un mayor rendimiento académico y mejores habilidades sociales de los estudiantes. Cuantos más padres y maestros compartan información relevante entre sí sobre un estudiante, mejor equipados estarán ambos para ayudar a ese estudiante a tener éxito académico.
